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THE RESULTS OF THIS REPORT PERTAIN ONLY TO THE SPECIFIC SAMPLE(S) EVALUATED.



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PREPARATION AND CONDITIONING: The sample material was submitted in sufficient quantity to form a specimen, 24" wide by 24' long. The sample was supported during testing by 1/4" round metal rods placed at two foot intervals across the width of the test chamber.

CONDITIONING: The test specimen was conditioned to a constant weight at a temperature of $73.4 \pm 5^{\circ}$ F (23 $\pm 2.8^{\circ}$ C) and a relative humidity of $50 \pm 5^{\circ}$.

CEMENT BOARD PLACEMENT: The 1/4" cement boards were placed between the test specimen and the chamber lid.

SUMMARY: FLAME SPREAD: 35 **SMOKE DEVELOPED:** 85

SUMMARY OF ASTM E84 RESULTS: Because of the possible variations in reproducibility, the results are adjusted to the nearest figure divisible by 5. Smoke Density values over 200 are rounded to the nearest figure divisible by 50.

In order to obtain the Flame Spread Classification, the above results should be compared to the following table:




